



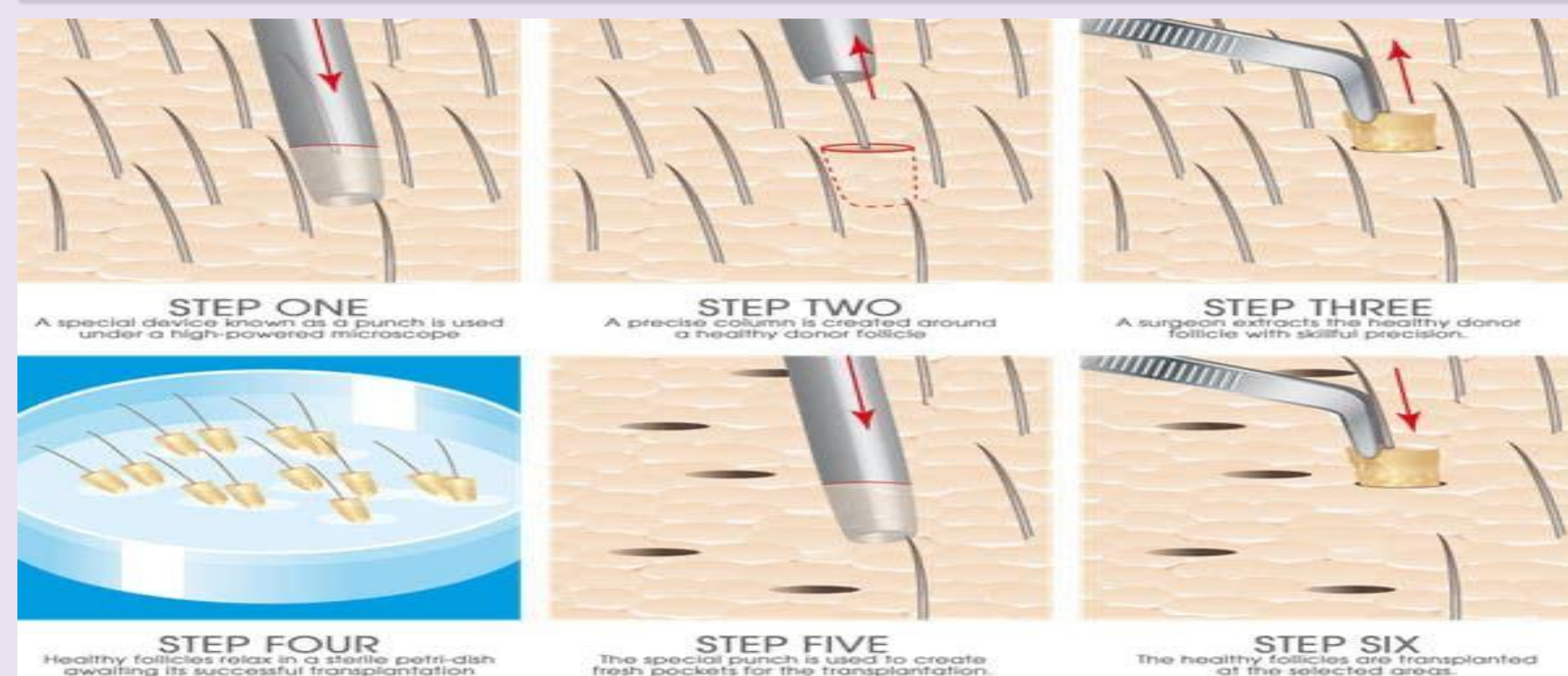
### Introduction

**Two types of hair transplantation techniques predominate, including follicular unit transplantation (FUT) and follicular unit extraction (FUE) techniques**

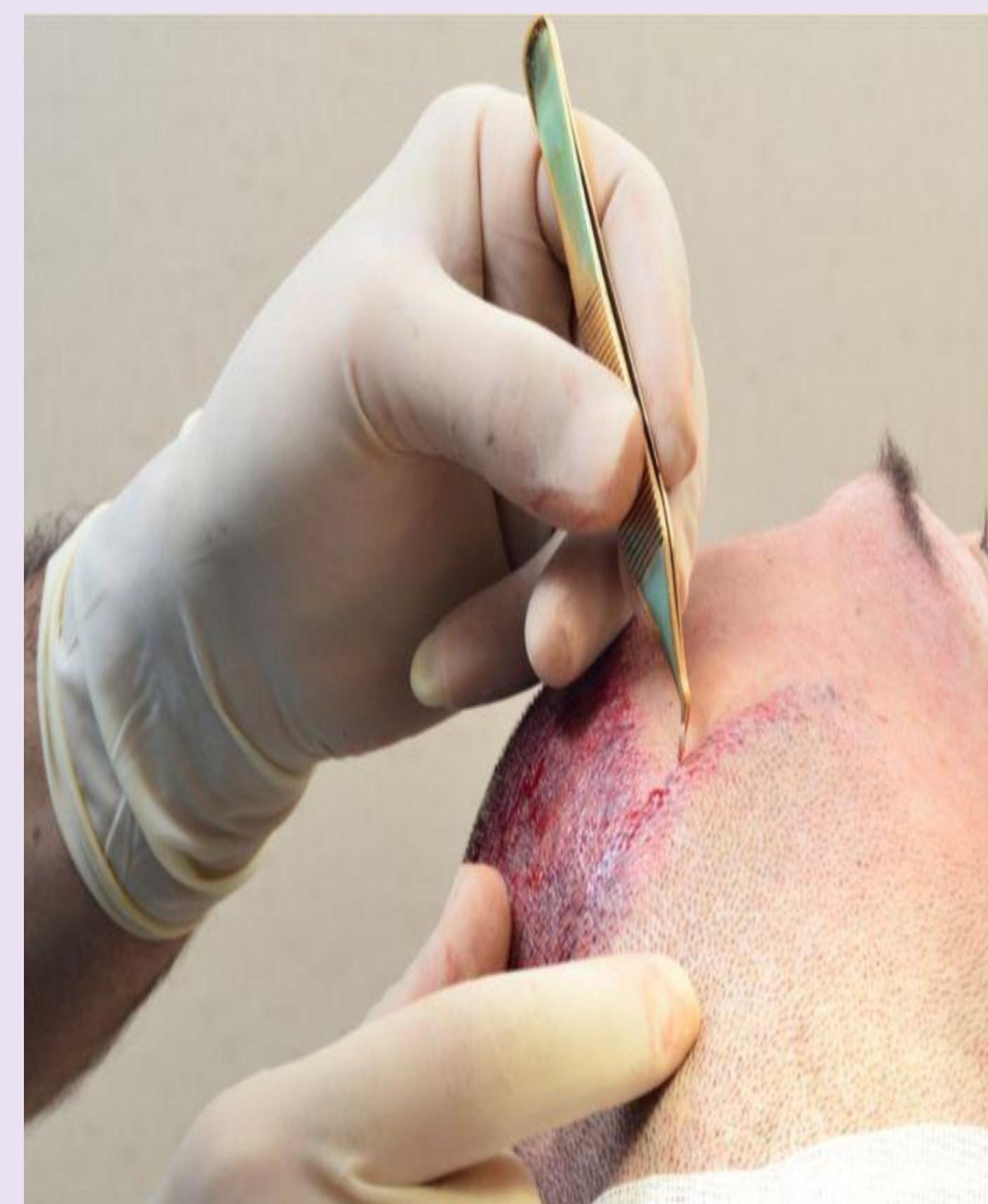
### Hair transplant steps

7. Aftercare
8. Final Results
